- Oak Wood Secondary School has been designated as a 'Lead School' for the Heart of England Music Hub. They will also be opening their new post-16 premises in the autumn term. We look forward to announcing the name shortly.
- Jade School (our specialist provision based at Brooklands Hospital) had a really positive and successful QNIC review last term.
- Oak Wood Primary School is continuing to work with Warwickshire to progress work on their expansion – we will keep you updated.
- Higham Lane School has achieved lots of sporting success recently, including the Year 9 and Year 11 football teams both winning the Nuneaton and District Cup in their age groups.
- Lots is happening in relation to Higham Lane North Academy, with a pre-opening Ofsted due to take place as well as a readiness to open meeting with the DfE in June.
