

# Improving Outcomes for Vocational Business

There are a number of ways to improve outcomes for the NCFE Level 1 / 2 Technical Award in Business & Enterprise, which your business teacher, will have explained to you regularly. Read carefully and use this document to remind yourself of what you have to do.

## 1. External Examination

**For students:** During the course you will have completed a number of workbooks on each topic area. These workbooks act as a revision guide for the course. You will also have extensive notes in your class book that should be used for revision. Your knowledge will also have developed during the NEA. The topic areas are:

- Entrepreneurship
- Marketing
- Human Resources
- Operations
- Business Growth
- Sources of Finance
- External Environment
- Business Plan

One of the main resources that you should be using is the free option from <https://revisionninja.com/> which has all the important content that you need for your exam. You should be using this information to prepare mind-maps or cue cards to test your knowledge. Revision will be done in lessons and should also be undertaken at home as your exam is worth **40%** of the course. You must pass the exam to be awarded a Level 2 qualification.

**For Parents/Carers:** Students are working on their NEA. They should be focused in lessons and working to complete 60%. When completed students will focus on the external exam. Students can use the following links for revision.
