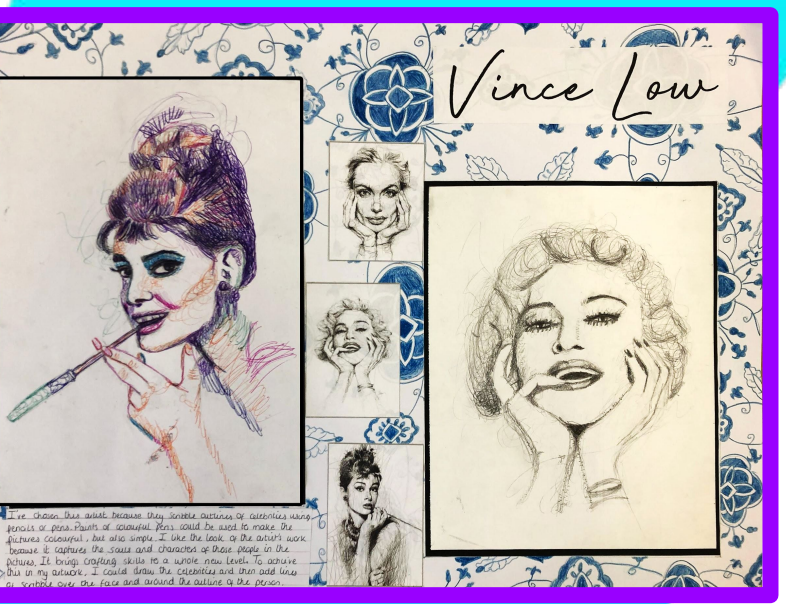

KEY SKILLS

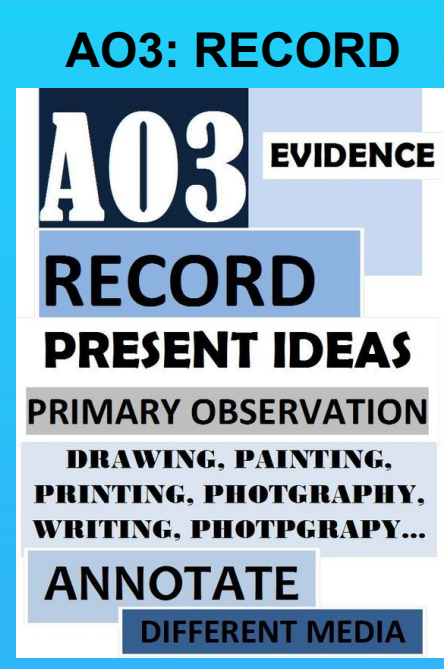

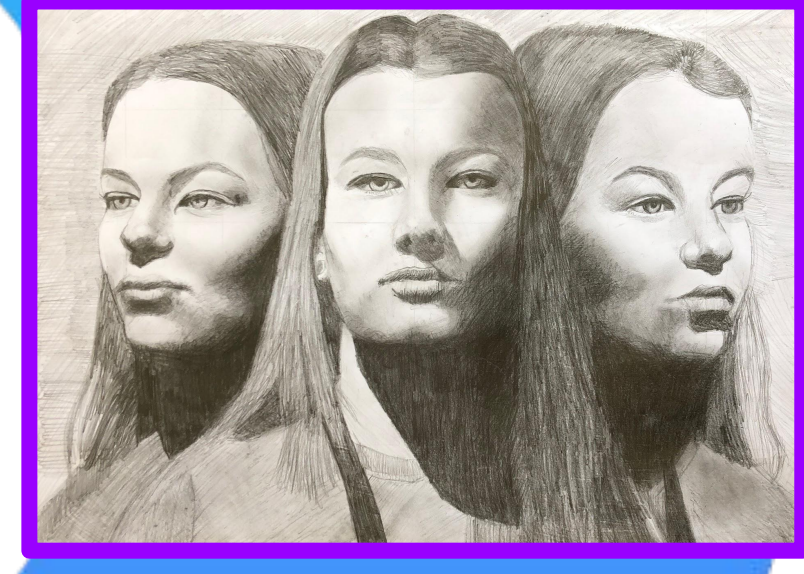

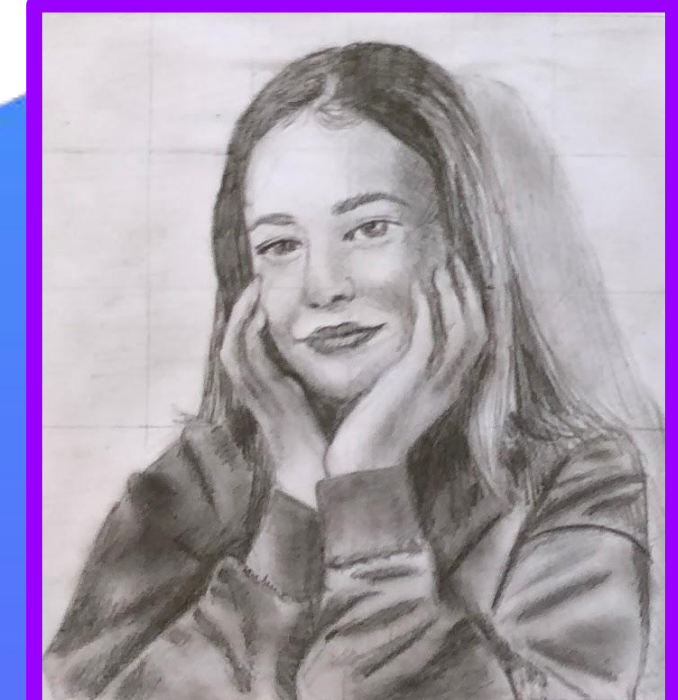

Teaching of each section will draw heavily on prior knowledge taught in KS3/Y9. Do Now activities will bring this knowledge forward.

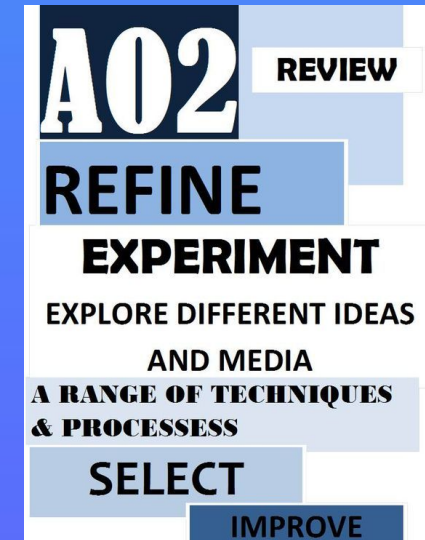


COMPONENT 1: AO3

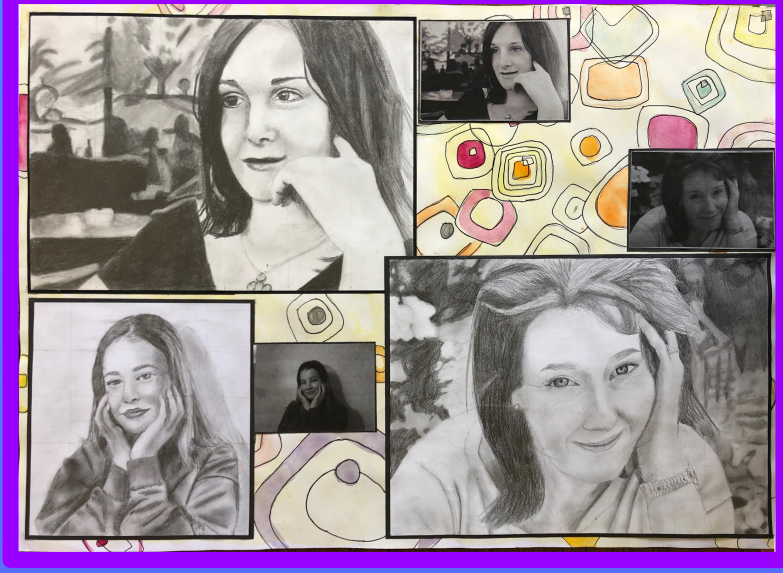
