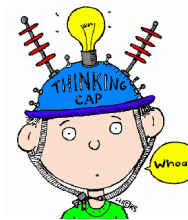


How can I revise for my Geography exams?

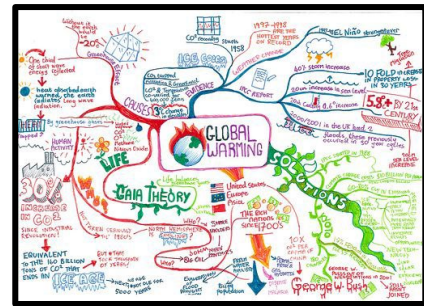
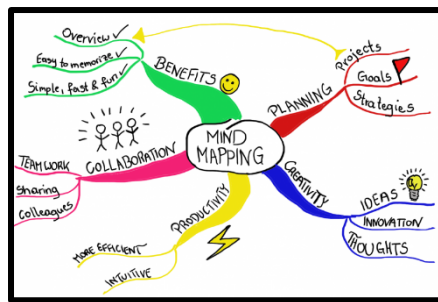

Using mind maps could help you put down your ideas from each of your topics in Year 7 and 8. Put down some of your work on an A3 sheets and revise from that. Make it colourful and eye-catching so that it is easy to revise from.



Revision Cards

Revision cards really help GCSE pupils, and this could also prove to be a really good revision tool at KS3. For example:

Year 7: Use one card to talk about the Causes of Volcanic eruptions and then another card to talk about its sustainable uses and the way they can make income.

Year 8: Use one card to talk about the causes of rapid urbanisation and population growth and then the other to talk about population control methods.
